



New Hampshire Housing
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INCUBATOR GRANT

Incubator grants are designed to help launch new organizations or programs that focus on housing education and advocacy. Approved organizations/programs will be expected to run for three years and may be eligible for Impact Grants to support future work.

Maximum Grant Award: \$20,000 for start-up organizations or \$50,000 for new programs at established organizations.

Matching funds required: No, however, this is a one-time-only grant opportunity.

Who is eligible:

- Established nonprofit economic/community development organizations that are going to create a new workforce housing education and advocacy program.
- Start-up organization whose primary mission will be workforce housing education and advocacy.

For-profit organizations, organizations engaged in housing development, municipal governments, and 501c4 organizations are not eligible. Previous recipients of an Incubator Grant are ineligible to apply.

Required information if invited to apply:

- Narrative describing the organizational history and structure.
- Work plan for the next 12 months outlining the following details:
 - o Description of your local housing challenges and opportunities for change related to land use regulations, processes, and/or public investment policies.
 - o Identify the work you will undertake to address these challenges and the outcomes you expect.
 - o Specifics on how these grant funds will be used to support your actions to reach intended goals.
- Financial information including prior year and current year to date financial statements, as well as a proposed budget for the next 12-months.

Additional information may be requested during the application process. If invited to apply, detailed instructions on how to format and submit your information will be provided. Grants may be approved at an amount lower than requested and, if approved, a grant contract will be created based on an agreed upon scope of work.
