NH HOUSING MINI GRANT

Mini Grants are available for groups that are directly involved with housing education and advocacy efforts. Funding for a mini grant can be used towards a variety of expenses related to activities that enhance and promote education to the general public or public officials regarding the need for housing.

Maximum Grant Award: \$5,000

Matching funds required: No, however, the availability of matching funds will be a consideration in the funding decision.

Who is eligible:

- Local or regional business groups
- Economic development groups
- Service organizations
- Ad hoc community groups
- Nonprofit organizations
- Local governments
- Regional Planning Commissions

Organizations engaged in housing development are not eligible for this funding.

Required information if invited to apply:

- Narrative outlining your organization's structure including members and their affiliations, mission, legal status, and fiscal agent.
- List of who will be involved in the project.
- Description of the purpose of this request including project goals, activities, and intended outcomes.
- Budget for the use of grant funds including any other sources of funding.

If invited to apply, detailed instructions and a fillable application form will be provided. Grants may be approved at an amount lower than requested, and, if approved, an agreement letter will be created based on the approved scope of work.
